

Make a Whale with your hand print!

1.) You will need: Paper, markers, finger paint or washable paint the is safe for skin

2.) Pick which type of whale you would like to create (circle)

**Toothed whale**                      **or**                      **Baleen Whale**

3.) Pick the color paint you would like to use (examples) :

Orca (toothed): Black and white

Blue whale (Baleen): Blue and white

Humpback whale (Baleen): Blue

Bottle nosed dolphin (toothed): Gray and blue

4.) Cover hand in finger paint with the colors of the species you picked out

5.) Press hand in this position (below). If you are creating a dolphin or an animal with a rostrum, you will have to create one with two fingers by pressing them in front of the head.



6.) After your hand print dries, you will use a marker or more paint to create a blowhole(s), eyes, mouths, teeth or baleen, a fluke, and the ecosystem surrounding it!

7.) For an extra challenge, label all parts of you whale by using the **worksheet 1** word bank.
